Handling of Personal Data

1. Introduction

27 Advisory AG is committed to complying with data protection laws and to thus ensuring the protection and confidentiality of your personal data. This Privacy Policy explains how we utilize data that you provide to us when using our website.

Our Privacy Policy only applies to the data generated when you visit our website.

Please read our Privacy Policy carefully before accessing our website and, in particular, before entering any personal data. By accessing the 27 Advisory AG website, you confirm that you agree to our Privacy Policy. If you do not agree to this statement, do not proceed to any further pages of our website.

2. Collection of data

We collect only personal information that you provide to us voluntarily, e.g. when making an enquiry. Personal data that is not anonymous, such as postal and e-mail addresses provided when submitting enquiries or requesting information, will be used primarily for the purpose of corresponding with you or sending you information.

Every time a user accesses the 27 Advisory AG website and every time a data file is retrieved, data relating to this procedure will be stored temporarily in a data log and processed, e.g. by using cookie technology. The specific data stored for each access/retrieval include the following: IP address, web browser, domain name, the time and date, the page accessed/name of file requested, the volume of data transferred, access status, i.e. if the access/request was successful. Anonymous information (e.g. data collected through the use of cookies) will only be used for statistical purposes and for the purpose of improving our website. Such data will subsequently be deleted. We will also use such non-personal information to make your use of our website easier. For example, we may use cookies to store your selected country of residence for the duration of a session so that you do not have to repeatedly enter the information.

Cookies

You acknowledge and agree to "cookies" technology being used in certain instances to provide you with information tailored to your needs. A cookie is an information file stored on a computer's hard drive to

ensure that it is recognized again on future visits to the 27 Advisory AG website. Your data will not at any time be linked to the personal data recorded at 27 Advisory AG.

How do I prevent the use of cookies?

Most browsers accept cookies automatically. You acknowledge that your browser can be set up to notify you about the receipt of cookies. You can withdraw your consent with regard to future use at any time by blocking the receipt of cookies in your browser settings. You can also delete cookies on your computer or mobile device using the feature for doing so in your browser.

Onsite targeting

On the 27 Advisory AG website, data is collected using cookie technology for use in optimizing our advertising and our overall online offering. This data is not used to identify you personally, but is instead used solely for anonymously analyzing the use of our website. Our goal here is to make our online presence as attractive for you as possible and to provide you with advertising that corresponds to your interests.

3. Transfer of data

Please be advised that data transferred across national borders over the Internet may not be subject to any control while in transit even if the sender and recipient are both located in the same country.

We cannot guarantee the security of data transferred over the Internet and accept no liability in respect thereof. Any notices emailed to us by you may not be secure. If you email any confidential information to us, you do so at your own risk. When contacting us, please send data via a secure mechanism, where appropriate, instead of over the Internet.

The sender and recipient can still be identified even when the information transmitted is encrypted. As a result, a third party could – inadvertently or otherwise – infer that there is a banking relationship between you and 27 Advisory AG.

4. Storage of data

Once you have transferred personal data to us, this data is stored on our servers for the purposes for which the information was provided.

We have implemented appropriate data security measures to ensure that this information is only accessible to a restricted number of authorized individuals and that it is protected against unauthorized access, misuse, loss or damage.

5. Use of data

We use non-anonymous personal data:

- for the purpose indicated when the information was submitted
- to render our services
- to provide information about new services and products
- to tailor services to client needs
- to update the address data of individuals with whom we maintain a business relationship

In this connection, we wish to expressly point out that we (further) evaluate any non-anonymous personal data submitted voluntarily by you and, in particular, can use this data to collect additional personal information about you from publicly accessible sources or publicly accessible collections of data. You herewith give your express consent to this process.

As a general rule, non-anonymous personal data are only made available to those employees or third parties who need to have knowledge of this information in order to provide products and services, or if we are required by law or regulatory provisions to disclose this information. To the extent permitted by law, we may also forward non-anonymous personal data for the above-described purposes to companies that provide services on our behalf. The data collected may be disclosed to service providers outside Switzerland or outside the country in which the user is domiciled. These service providers are required to treat as confidential the information and all data collected and to use it exclusively for the purposes for which it is provided.

Companies, agents and third-party service providers associated with 27 Advisory AG that have access to personal data collected via the 27 Advisory AG website have to comply with data protection requirements. In the event that any personal data are transferred to other countries, we ensure that the applicable laws and regulations are complied with by, for example, concluding

agreements that ensure the recipients of your data maintain an appropriate level of data protection.

Certain countries may have more stringent data protection provisions which may not allow your non-anonymous personal data to be used in these countries to the extent described above. Such provisions may preclude, for example, the collection of additional personal data based on information you provided or the disclosure of your personal data to other parties or companies.

No personal data are sold to other parties.

6. Your rights, further information and how to contact us

You have a right to information regarding personal data stored in relation to you. You are also entitled to have any inaccuracies in your personal data corrected, or to have your data blocked or deleted.

7. Withdrawal of consent and opting out

You may withdraw your consent to the collection, storage and use of your personal data at any time with future effect by writing to us or sending an email. You may also notify us by letter or email at any time that you wish to opt out of the use of your information for advertising or marketing purposes.
